

Video assessments 2019



Resolution Institute conducts video assessments of candidates who wish to **apply** for mediation accreditation under the National Mediator Accreditation System (NMAS).

Candidates for video assessment need to have either:

- Completed a LEADR or IAMA mediation workshop, or
- Applied to Resolution Institute to have their training recognised as having met the knowledge, skills and ethical understandings described by the national accreditation standards

When is a good time to sit the assessment?

Every candidate is different and can choose when they wish to sit the assessment. Many candidates find it helpful to sit their assessment between *6 weeks to 3 months* once their training is completed, as it gives them the opportunity to:

- Arrange practice sessions with other graduates of their mediation training course or with other colleagues
- Gain experience of the assessment process by role playing for other candidates
- Reflect on their training and put the approach and skills they have learnt into practice in work and home settings
- Review their training materials thoroughly

How is a video assessment organised?

By email, we:

- Offer a time and date for an assessment and ask you to reply accepting this offer
- Confirm this time and date
- Send you the scenario and other materials about one week before the assessment.

How is the assessment conducted?

- The candidate conducts a mediation simulation as mediator for 1.5–2 hours.
- Volunteers play the role of the two parties in the simulated dispute.
- The simulation is video recorded and sent to an assessor for assessment against a set of core mediation competencies.
- Within approximately four weeks we inform you of the outcome. If assessed as:
 - *competent*, we invite you to apply for Accreditation
 - *not yet competent*, we send the video to a second assessor. Depending on the outcome, we invite you to apply for accreditation or to develop your skills and competencies before taking another assessment.
- We email you a result letter, evaluation/s and application for national accreditation.

Video assessment fee

\$697 (inc GST)

Results are released when full payment is received. Due to our commitments to suppliers, there is a 10% cancellation charge for notification less than one week prior to the event.
